COMOX VALLEY MIXED PUB DART LEAGUE RULES

- 1. All teams will be mixed
 - A At least 2 women/men per team
 - B Minimum of 5 active players
 - C Maximum of 8 players
 - D 9 games of 701 straight in double out
 - E Games are to be played Tuesdays and are to start at 7:30 pm
 - F All Players will be rotated fairly and evenly each game, including the 1st player of each game
 - G A player of the opposite sex must play in every game both in regular league and playoffs
- 2. If only 3 players are available, a dummy score of 26 will be scored for the fourth player until 100 is reached, and then will be discontinued and players will rotate normally. If less than 3 players then it's a forfeit and the other team will receive all 9 points.
- 3. Each team captain will complete and submit a score sheet <u>if you are not playing at the Courtenay Legion</u>, (only one sheet is required if you <u>are</u> playing at the Courtenay Legion) filled out in full, all players playing that night and team names are to be included on the sheet. Please make sure the sheet is legible. Also all high scores and high checkouts and 180's if they are not on that sheet they will not count. No Exceptions. You can scan or take a picture of your score sheet and send it to Geoff (<u>comoxphil.46@gmail.com</u>) then when you play his team (Courtenay Legion D.A.'s) you can hand him your sheet or if you're playing at the Courtenay Legion you can drop the original sheet off then.
- 4. Results of each Tuesday's games are due no later than noon Thursday
 - to be dropped off at the Courtenay Legion (box near the sign in book)
 - phoned in to Geoff Phillips 250-871-3707 (hard copy to him as soon as possible)
 - emailed to him @ comoxphil.46@gmail.com (hard copy to him as soon as possible)
- 5. Changing teams only by mutual consent of both teams and executive approval.
 If adding or replacing a player or have a player leaving please notify the statistician. Fees are \$ 22.00 per player for the season, this is non refundable and payable in cash or by cheque made payable to <u>Lona Dennis</u> by October 1st, 2019.
- 6. The handicap system will be in place again this year. Totals will be published weekly.
- 7. Teams can call up a spare player if only 4 members of their team or less are available to a maximum of 5 players including the spares. Spares will pay a fee of \$ 2.00 per night and money can be attached to the score sheet, please provide player information with that, or can be given to any executive member with team and player info.
- 8. All postponed games will be rescheduled by captains of both teams. 24 hours notice for postponed games or all points will be forfeited unless due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. Maximum of 3 weeks to make up games. Let the statistician know of postponement and also of date for makeup game (by both captains)
- 9. Any discrepancies or complaints should be written on the back of the score sheet or on the provided complaint sheet. Please include names of all players involved as well as both team names and all details.
- 10. When you are chalking please have courtesy for the shooter, do not put your face in front of the board or move around, be still as possible. If you are chalking you may tell the shooter what to shoot at if the shooter requests. It is advised that the shooter step back from the toeline and look to their own team for someone to let them

know what to shoot. Please do not yell out from behind the shooter. Chalking for the opposing team that is short players is a courtesy not a requirement.

- 11. At no given time should anyone but the shooter and the chalker be figuring out the score if there is a problem then they need to get the captains (or acting captains) from both teams to check the score. Do not pull your darts from the board until you and the chalker have agreed on the score. If you pull your darts and you do not agree with the chalker or vise versa then your score will count as zero.
- 12. When shooting your foot should be behind the toeline at all times. If your foot crosses the toeline at anytime while shooting your score will count as zero and your turn will be forfeited.
- 13. Each player is subject to a toeline time of 20 seconds with the exception that player is in the bathroom. Failure to do so will result in a score of 26 being scored in lieu of the turn.
- 14. The use of a toe board is prohibited. Please use either tape or a mat.
- 15. If there are only 3 or 4 players on the team that night, a QUICK 5 minute smoke break is allowed.
- 16. Year end banquet will be potluck, (location to be determined). Each team is required to provide a dish to be shared as well as a door prize minimum \$ 25.00 value
- 17. Cash prizes will be distributed to winning teams and individuals at this potluck get together.
